Services

Community Shop

The community shop based within the One Stop Shop has now been refurbished with a large number of new and used items for sale. The community shop has been open since September 2008 with the refurbishment completed in May. The revenue from the sale of goods goes back into the Charity to cover the many running costs. This allows us to continue to deliver vital services (some of which are detailed overleaf) to the community. We can accept most unwanted items of clothing, shoes, bags, ornaments, furniture etc. We also provide a recycling service for items unsuitable for re-sale. This service provides other charities with the opportunity to raise vital funds for the most vulnerable in our society and also helps the environment. We only accept clothes, shoes and bags for recycling, unfortunately we cannot accept any larger items. The Community Shop is run by a number of volunteers and is open Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 10.00 am - 2.00 pm but access out with these times can be arranged by asking at the Post Office or by contacting Helen or George on the above telephone number. Computer Courses - West of Scotland University

Computer Courses will be starting in September 2009. These courses will be on a Wednesday and each course will last 3 hours over a period of 12 weeks. A number of various courses will be available through West of Scotland University. These courses can be funded through ILA (Individual Learning Accounts). £200 is available for anyone earning less than £18,000 and for those on benefits. This is vital in a community where there is high unemployment so please give your support and sign up now. The One Stop Shop staff are dedicated in providing as much services to the local community as possible but can only do so with local support.

Fruit & Vegetables

Fresh Fruit & Vegetables are for sale daily in the Community Shop or when shop is closed at the Post Office. This is sourced locally and fresh daily from the market. Ham, fish etc is also available and all items can be ordered and delivered fresh next day. Items ordered on a Tuesday will not be available until Thursday. Soft drinks, water etc are also on sale.

Conference Facilities/Room Hire

Coalburn One Stop Shop Charitable Society have a number of rooms available for hire. The size varies from conference size holding approximately 250 to small interview rooms. There has been a new state of the art PA system with hearing loop installed in the main hall and also a new PA system installed in the smaller hall. CAB

The Citizens Advice Bureau is in the One Stop Shop every Friday except the first Friday of the month from 11.00 am - 1.00pm.

Routes to Work South

Routes to Work South are in the One Stop Shop every second Tuesday from 12.30pm - 2.30pm. This is a service to help unemployed people back into work.

CISWO

A Social Worker from CISWO (Coal Industry Social Welfare Organisation) is in attendance at the One Stop Shop every second Friday from 10.00 am - 12.00 noon.

Councillor's Surgeries

Councillor McInnes holds his surgery in the One Stop Shop on the third Monday each month from 6.00pm - 7.00pm. Councillor Manson holds his surgery every third Wednesday each month from 6.30pm - 7.30pm. Mr David Mundell also holds surgeries in the One Stop Shop. The date of Mr Mundell's surgery is advertised in the local press approximately one month prior to surgery and also displayed on the notice board in the Centre. Karen Gillon MSP holds a surgery in the One Stop Shop every two months.

Post Office

The local Post office is based within the One Stop Shop. The franchise was secured in February 2007 and has been very well used.
